

## REMOVAL OF OBSOLETE CLP NOTIFICATIONS:

There is no FAQ on this topic, but according to Eurometaux, ECHA will prepare one to be added to the guide they specifically developed for this exercise.

Because that may take some time, notifiers can refer to the Industry Manual part 6, under “further guidance and information” on ECHA’s website:

This manual was initially devised for registrations but according to ECHA the same rules apply to obsolete notifications.

Via REACH-IT it appears to be quite straightforward.

After entering the REACH-IT account, one would need to select “cease manufacture” that also serves to remove obsolete classifications:



The second step is to find and select the substances the notifier wishes to “cease manufacturing” or remove their notification for.
